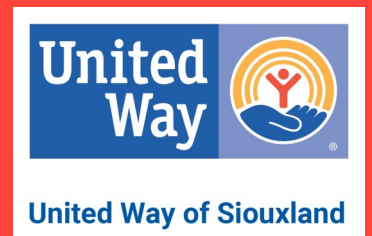

“If it wasn’t for Pathway of Hope and the Salvation Army, I would never have learned my strengths,” said Shelly.

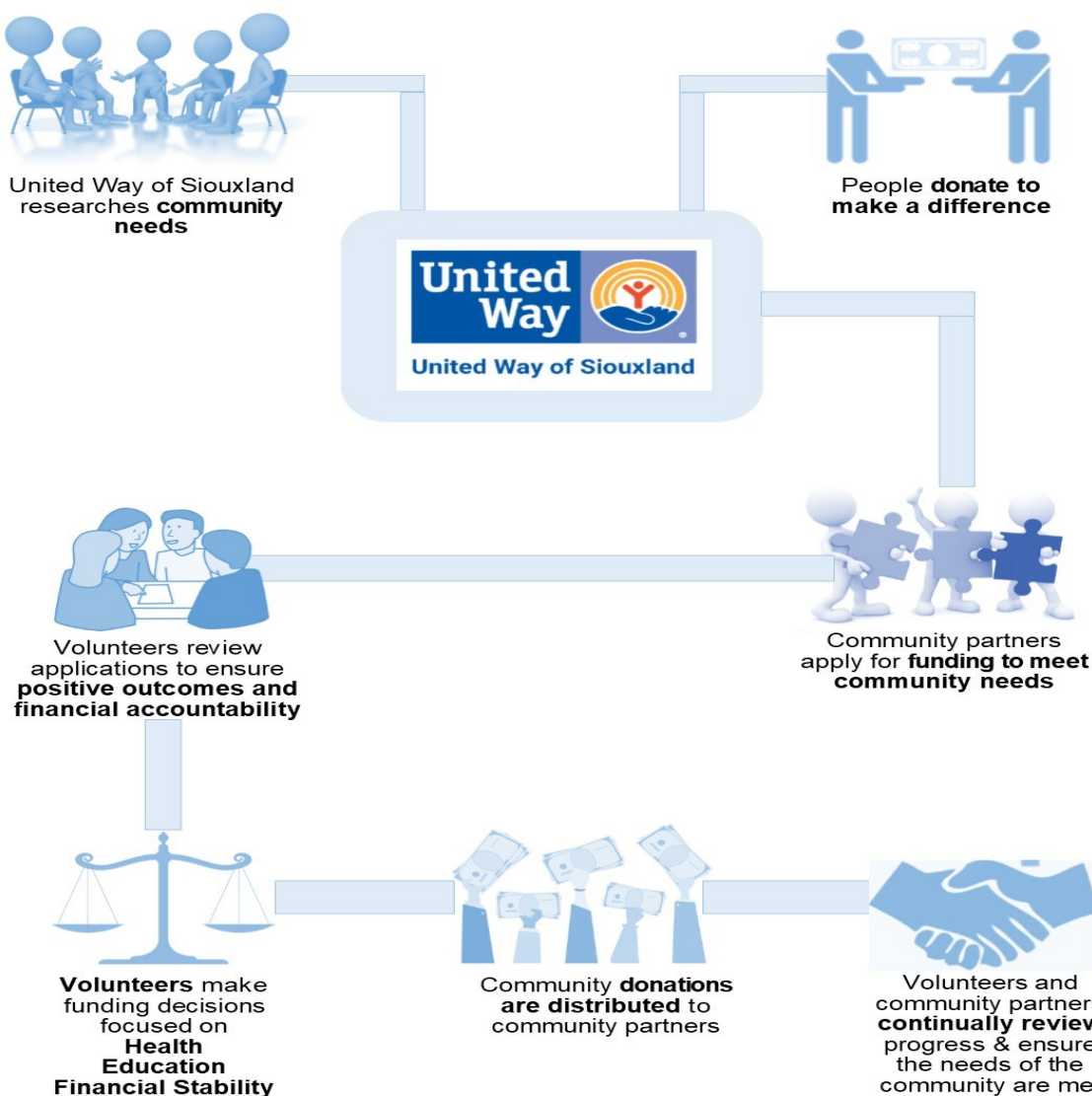
“I have more strengths than I give myself credit for – I’m a good mom, have an awesome work ethic and I love my job.”
