We Thrive

Approximately 19,700 Siouxlanders were served through United Ways 23 locally funded programs focused on improving the health and education of our community.

The following results are highlights of the positive impact you've helped make possible in the past 12 months through United Way of Siouxland. Thank you for your support!

Goal 1: Individuals access mental health and addiction resources

- **2,968 parents** built stronger families through parent education and resources.
- **7,941 children, teens, and adults** found the care and support they needed to improve their mental health.

Goal 2: Adult learners become more employable and independent in the community

- **3,005 local residents** strengthened their financial future through job training, financial coaching, or free tax preparation.
- **More than 2,500 local taxpayers** claimed **\$937,200** in refunds—helping families pay bills, reduce debt, and build financial stability.

Goal 3: Individuals engage in behaviors that improve their health or safety

- **1,131 youth** built healthier futures through mental health and substance use prevention education and support.
- **639 children** began healing from the trauma of abuse through specialized therapy.
- **1,133 survivors of domestic violence** found safety, advocacy, and a path toward a brighter future.

Goal 4: Families access quality childcare and early learning opportunities

- **1,007 children** built a strong foundation for kindergarten through quality preschool and child care.
- **11 new registered in-home child care providers** expanded quality child care options for working families.

Goal 5: Youth demonstrate grade-appropriate school readiness academically, socially, and emotionally

- **1,700 children** had a safe place to learn and grow through after-school and summer programs.
- **1,463 students** improved academically—bringing them one step closer to graduation.
- **1,727 children** received a monthly book to increase early literacy skills.
