Types of Programs:

- Licensed, registered and nonregistered
- Home programs serving 5 or less children do not need to be registered in Iowa

Signs of Quality Care:

- Parents always have access to their child
- Supervision at all times, even naps
- Program has written emergency procedures
- Safe Sleep practices are used
- Balance of time for play, activities & rest
- Toddlers have opportunities to move about
- Program involves family members in activities & daily updates
- Provider utilizes professional development to improve services
